In her paintings Sascha Braunig investigates the restraining confines of the canvas through a mixture of portraiture, Surrealism and luminescent abstraction. The undulating, fantastical forms she commits to canvas are faithful interpretations of still lives she stages herself. Typically, she molds and lights sculptures as the subject of each piece, before entering a meditative state in which she skins her creations with ornate patterns.
